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#### 6. Chairman's Report:

Fairly quiet at the moment, there are youths causing antisocial behaviour within the park, security have been fantastic in dealing with various incidents. Cllr. Falat read out an event where security had gone the extra mile to help someone.

District Cllr. Gee reported that it is quiet at the moment due to being officially in purdah. The bridge is getting closer to being opened, just doing the final checks and could be ready June or July. It will probably be opened by a Royal but due to not having a date set it could clash. Cllr. Falat has identified 28 Road signs that will direct traffic the wrong way once the bridge is opened.

Cllr. Falat produced a draft questionnaire which, when finalised will be included in the Parish Press.

#### 1. Finance report

Cllr. Falat discussed the end of year figures and reported the overall income was £683,522.07. The expenditure was £687,505.90. Which is a deficit of £3,983.83 which is not too bad.

#### 2. Personnel Report

No meetings so nothing to report.

#### 3. Events & Tourism report

Cllr. Ashdown discussed the egg hunt and reported they made £500.75 clear profit for the park with the event. More eggs had to be purchased as they ran out. Cllr. Bromley and Admin Assistant were a huge help. There are 32 eggs left which are going to be made into chocolate slabs and sold at the parish picnic. Cllr. Ashdown raised the doughnut van in the park for the summer, this was discussed, and it was agreed to decide after the parish picnic as the van will be in the park for the event. If it is agreed to allow him in the park for the summer, the cafés will need to be included in the decision.
