Complaint received from a member of public; Cllr Falat would like to note the member of public has never attended a planning meeting.

A meeting took place regarding the signage for Oulton Broad attended by: Peter Aldous, Andrée Gee, Eddy Back and Ben Falat (Keith Robinson held up by traffic) [Apology from Sandra Keller]

In summary:-

1 Ben Falat (Oulton Broad Parish) presented a pictorial overview of road signs (copied at attachment). Whereas reduced traffic flow through Oulton Broad will be of merit, there is potential de-merit of visitors for both tourism and business being dissuaded from accessing Oulton Broad; I've tried to reflect these interests with the 'Brown Sign' at attachment (obviously final design sitting with Suffolk Highways). Potentially such Brown-Signage could be at zero cost to OBPC because of the general need for wider signs replacement; Aldous, Back and Gee were all moved to agree that there was a wider issue of signage and grateful to OBPC for highlighting this.

Once the new Gull-Wing route is opened, unless corrections/alterations are made, there will exist some anomalies which will certainly affect Oulton Broad.

During his site-investigations of the District a whole raft of other signages became apparent as potentially in due course sending WRONG Messages to traffic.

It was suggested that in view of the very necessary re-routing of A47/A12 Trunk traffic across the GullWing Bridge, there exists opportunity for Oulton Broad to benefit from at very least some "Brown-Sign" insertions towards The Broad, Tourism, Accommodation, Fuelling and Local Business, all attendees agreed.

Peter Aldous asked whether Minutes had been kept of previous Lake Lothing Crossing Stakeholder Meetings which might give weight to the present issue.

As early as Fri-22-March-2019, Item-5 in the Minutes, in response to a call for appropriate road signs reflecting strategy of The Broads Authority as well as wishes of Oulton Broad Parish state:-

"... JB [Project Manager, SCC] assured the group that there will be a signage strategy, ... ".

During later meetings BF reiterated this Parish wish for remedial signage particularly to redirect tourist traffic towards the otherwise circumvented locality of Oulton Broad.

This new signage strategy is not yet evident.

3 It is now suggested that Suffolk (Highways) be asked as a late but integral part of the GullWing project to effect the promised new signage strategy,

(i) to survey the District for appropriate re-signing, liaising with local councillors, for Green routings, White local directions, Brown invitations.
