District Cllr. Back said it was quiet. Budgets are being worked currently.

District Cllr. Gee said there will be a public consultation on the tidal flood barrier which starts today and goes onto 12th January 2023. It's at the Pier Pavilion 23 November 2022 2pm to 7pm and 24th November 2022 10am to 4pm to discuss the plans and look at them.

District Cllr. Gee visited Bonds Meadow Foundation and they have done a wonderful job. There are concerns of slow encroachment of the rear gardens in Chestnut Avenue, planning had been notified but nothing had been done so she has raised it again with several people.

9. To receive an update from FoNEP and agree any necessary action:

FoNEP reported that having discussed the park areas Adrian has put forward the following:

1. Widen the bed adjacent to the sweet shop and continue with the planting but more colour.
2. Long term safety for pedestrians, installing concrete slopes through the pedestrian gates leading to the gravel paths off the road.
3. Hard surface to the island of the boating lake with a statue or boat on it.
4. Remove the grass areas along the boulevard and plant with perennials
5. Clear and re-plant shrubs on the section in front of the old dairy.
6. Re-plant other flower beds around the park

OB British Legion flag will be coming back to the area, it will probably be rehomed to St Mark's Church.
